

## Handouts A, B, and C Answer Keys

### Handout A: Defining Civic Virtue

1. Accept reasoned responses.
2. Accept reasoned responses.
3. Responses should make a reasonable connection between civic virtue and the principles of a constitutional republic.

### Handout B: Clarifying Civic Virtue

1. Responses will vary, but should demonstrate expansion beyond the response given in **Handout A**.
2. Responses will vary. If a student's response did not change at all, ask clarifying questions to gauge the student's critical thinking and engagement with the ideas from the reading and discussion.  
  
Whether or not a student changed his/her response, he/she should be able to provide textual evidence to support his/her reasons for doing so—or not doing so.
3. Responses should make a reasonable connection between civic virtue and the principles of a constitutional republic.

### Handout C: Identifying and Defining Civic Virtues

Accept responses that demonstrate an understanding of each definition and a reasonable example and explanation.
